Debbie Cavaliere to represent Alberta Liberals in Edmonton-Meadowlark

Edmonton – Former Catholic School Board Trustee and Board Chair Debbie Cavaliere emerged as the winner this evening in the Alberta Liberals' Edmonton-Meadowlark nomination contest. Cavaliere defeated Edmonton lawyer Bruce King to win the right to run as an Alberta Liberal in Edmonton-Meadowlark in the next provincial election. Cavaliere served on the Edmonton Catholic School Board as a Trustee for two terms from 2001 – 2007. She was Chair of the Board for two years, from 2005 – 2006.
